## Belgian economy grew by 0.2% in the second quarter of 2024

According to the flash estimate, seasonally and calendar adjusted gross domestic product (GDP) grew by 0.2% in volume terms in the **second quarter of 2024** compared with the previous quarter. In comparison with the second quarter of 2023, growth came to 1.1%.

An initial estimate shows that, in comparison to the previous quarter, value added was down by 0.3% in industry. The services sector recorded positive growth of 0.2%. Value added rose by 1.1% in the construction industry.
