Monthly consumer survey - July 2024

Consumer confidence weakens in July

- After markedly improving last month, the consumer confidence indicator fell back in July.
- There was a worsening in all components of the indicator.

Consumer expectations for the general economic situation in Belgium have dropped slightly. In addition, fears of a rise in unemployment over the next twelve months have sharply intensified, following the clear abatement last month.


On a personal level, households say they are less confident about their own future financial situation, and less optimistic about their savings intentions over the coming twelve months.






Expectations for the next twelve months
